

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

Q. How can I purchase Sky box tickets?

A. Current Sky box holders have the first right of refusal to purchase the season ticket. When seats become available, names must be on the waitlist for consideration.

Q. What is the requirement to be a Sky box holder?

A. You must be an active Alumni, Associate or Life Member, contribute to the National Alumni Scholarship Fund, and pay the seat fee.

Q. What is the annual cost of Skybox?

A. The average cost for each seat range from \$300-\$500 depending on the number of home games.

Q. When is payment due?

A. Current skybox holders will be notified in writing when the payment is due. The entire cost for the skybox seat is due June 15. Partial payment is not accepted.

Q. Are parking passes included in the costs?

A. The University Skybox comes with a limited number of VIP parking passes to all skybox holders. The National Alumni Association has no control of the number of VIP parking passes that are distributed by the University. Therefore, the first paid will receive VIP parking passes.

Q. How can I get on the waitlist?

A. Apply through the National Alumni Website link at <u>skybox@aamualumni.org</u>. You will submit your name, address, phone, email address, number of seats, and put if you are a member of the Alumni Association. You can also contact the Alumni Affairs office at 256-372-5287. Names are listed in priority order of date requested.

Q. Do waitlist patrons have to re-apply every year?

A. No, waitlist patrons do not have to re-apply every year. Their name(s) will remain on the waitlist until a vacant seat becomes available. An email or letter will be sent out on waitlist status.

Q. Are children allowed in the Alumni Skybox?

A. No one under 19 years of age are allowed in the Alumni Sky box during the football games, only after the game. Please note you will be asked to leave the skybox, refunds will not be given.

Q. Are pets allowed in the Alumni Skybox?

A. Pets are not allowed in the Alumni Skybox. Other animals such as service dogs falls under the University rules.



- Q. What does the suite package include?
- A. The suite offers season game tickets, catered meal, beverages, and game programs.
- Q. What are the amenities?

A. In addition to being protected from inclement weather during the game, the suite has interior climate-controlled, three flat screen televisions, private restrooms, elevator access and attendant.

Q. When should I arrive?

A. The Alumni Skybox suite open 1 hour and 30 minutes prior to kickoff, and will remain open 1 hour after the game.

Q. Can I smoke in the Alumni Sky box?

A. Alabama A&M University and the Louis Crews Stadium is a smoke-free facility.

Q. Can tickets be transferred to family member of a deceased skybox holder?

A. Yes, the family member will have the first right of refusal and accept the appropriate terms set forth by the National Alumni Association, Inc.
